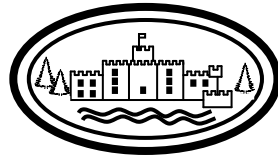

Code of Conduct

In order to encourage good behaviour the pupils, staff, parents and the Board of Governors have agreed a 'Code of Conduct' which provides the guidance for positive behaviour and therefore creates an environment conducive to effective teaching and learning. - line up quickly and quietly when the bell rings
- don't use bad language
- treat others as you would like to be treated yourself
